Concerto Competition

Registration Deadline: Friday, February 24th

We are excited to announce the 1st Annual Prosper ISD Concerto Competition open to grades 6-12. This competition is designed for students who have a desire to challenge themselves artistically and technically.

Performing in an orchestra provides every student the joy of making music with their peers, but the concerto competition provides an opportunity for students to demonstrate their soloistic ability. This competition will allow you to utilize the skills you have obtained through orchestra class and private lessons in a competitive environment.

At the preliminary round on April 22, the finalists will be chosen by the judge(s) to perform at a recital on April 26 in front of a live audience and judges. At the conclusion of this recital, the judges will choose one winner from the high school level and one winner from the middle school level. Prizes will be awarded to the winners.

In order to compete in the concerto competition, the following criteria must be met:

- Students may not perform a piece they previously performed at a past Solo & Ensemble Contest
- A live piano accompanist is required (accompanist fee will apply)
- Middle school students must prepare a piece from Suzuki Book 3 or higher
 - A piece may be performed from a comparable book if approved by your orchestra director
- Due to copyright law, an original (no photo copies) piano score of the piece to be performed must be provided to your orchestra director by the entry deadline

Entry Requirements:

- Complete the entry form by February 24, 2023
- Make the \$16 entry fee payment by February 24, 2023 link to pay is on the entry form
- Provide the original piano score to your orchestra director by February 24, 2023

Students should be practicing 20 minutes a day, 5 days a week. Please encourage your student to carve out time for practice. Practice logs are due with a signature every Monday.
















Camerata Orchestra Update - Intermediate - 8th Period
